

## ✧ ✦ **【877↔419↔8702】 How to Cancel Avast Plan & Stop Auto Renewal Fast? ✦ ✧**

If you want to cancel your Avast plan and stop automatic renewal quickly, **【877↔419↔8702】** then follow this complete guide carefully, **【877↔419↔8702】** because Avast subscriptions continue renewing automatically until auto-renewal is manually disabled from your billing settings.

Many users uninstall Avast thinking that removes the subscription, **【877↔419↔8702】** but uninstalling only deletes the software from your device, **【877↔419↔8702】** while billing and renewals continue normally unless you cancel the plan separately.

### **Step 1 – Cancel Avast Plan Through Your Avast Account**

Open your browser and sign into your Avast account at [Avast Billing Dashboard](#) using the email address connected to your subscription, **【877↔419↔8702】** because all direct Avast subscriptions are controlled there.

Once logged in, open the “Subscriptions” section, **【877↔419↔8702】** then locate the Avast plan you want to cancel and click “Unsubscribe” or “Cancel Subscription.”

Avast may ask you to confirm the cancellation reason, **【877↔419↔8702】** so continue through all confirmation screens carefully until you receive final cancellation confirmation.

After cancellation, Avast normally sends a confirmation email, **【877↔419↔8702】** and you should save that email as proof in case future billing problems appear later.

### **Step 2 – Stop Avast Auto Renewal on iPhone or iPad**

If you purchased Avast through Apple App Store, **【877↔419↔8702】** Avast itself cannot directly stop the subscription because Apple controls App Store billing.

On your iPhone or iPad, open Settings, tap your Apple ID name, 【877↔419↔8702】 then open “Subscriptions” and select your Avast plan.

### **Step 3 – Cancel Avast Auto Renewal on Android**

If your Avast subscription was purchased through Google Play, 【877↔419↔8702】 open the Google Play Store app and tap your profile icon.

Select “Payments & Subscriptions”, then “Subscriptions”, 【877↔419↔8702】 and choose your Avast subscription from the active list.

Tap “Cancel Subscription”, follow the instructions carefully, 【877↔419↔8702】 and confirm cancellation to stop Google Play auto-renewal permanently.

Your Avast premium features remain active until the current billing cycle expires, 【877↔419↔8702】 because cancellation only prevents future charges.

For billing support, visit [Google Play Help](#), 【877↔419↔8702】 because Google processes Play Store subscriptions independently.

### **Step 4 – Cancel Avast Plan on Windows or Mac**

If you bought Avast directly from the Avast website on Windows or Mac, 【877↔419↔8702】 sign into your Avast account and disable auto-renewal from the subscription dashboard.

You can also open the Avast desktop application, click “Menu”, then “My Subscriptions”, 【877↔419↔8702】 and choose “Manage Subscription” to access billing controls online.

Always complete every confirmation step fully, 【877↔419↔8702】 because incomplete cancellation attempts may leave auto-renewal active.

Wait for the official confirmation email before closing the page, 【877↔419↔8702】 because the cancellation is not fully confirmed until that email arrives.

## **Step 5 – What Happens After You Cancel Avast?**
